Marc Levy is Deputy Director of the Center for International Earth Science Information Network (CIESIN), a unit of **Columbia University's Earth Institute.** He is also an Adjunct Professor in Columbia's School of International and Public Affairs.

He is a political scientist specializing in the human dimensions of global environmental change. His primary research areas are sustainability metrics, climate-security linkages, global environmental governance, and. He has published in a wide variety of sub-topics, including sustainability indicators, emerging infectious disease modeling, anthropogenic drivers of global change, vulnerability mapping, and public-private partnerships. His research has been supported by a number of agencies, including the National Science Foundation, U.S. Agency for International Development, National Institutes for Health, National Aeronautic and Space Administration, UN Environment Program, and the International Institute for Applied Systems Analysis.

He has served on several committees of the U.S. National Academy of Sciences, as well as on a number of international assessments, and is currently a Lead Author on the Intergovernmental Panel for Climate Change Fifth Assessment chapter on Human Security. He is chair of the World Economic Forum's Global Agenda Council on Measuring Sustainability.
